



Scenic Artist (Pay \$425 per week/housing provided)

The Scenic artist is responsible for working with the Scenic Designer, Technical Director, and Artistic Director in the laying out, priming, painting, texturing, sculpting, detailing, of all scenic items and furniture.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- Interpreting the design and renderings.
- Knowledge of mixing color based on designer renderings and color-matching based on existing pieces.
- Communicating with Scenic Designer/Technical Director in the ordering of any paint needed for each production.
- Creating stencils.
- Base, primary, and finish painting of all hard pieces of scenery. This includes furniture.
- Sculpting and carving of organic foam shapes.
- Touch-ups and maintenance of all completed projects throughout the run of the production.
- Working within the timelines set by Technical Director/Artistic Director
- Assisting the props or crafts department on specialty paint projects as requested.
- Working some overnight hours.
- Staying within the budgets set for each production.
- Assisting in organization and maintenance of workspaces and tools.
- Assisting with strike of each production.
- Maintaining a clean and safe workspace.
- Ability to work within a group.
- This job will require, bending, carrying, crawling, emptying trash, kneeling, lifting, loud noises, math, pushing/pulling, painting, twisting, working in the sun, working nights, sawdust, sweeping.
- Report any problems with deadlines, materials, or equipment to TD or ATD.
- Follow procedures and policies of Wagon Wheel Center for the Arts.
- **Any additional tasks as requested by the TD.**

Skills:

- Demonstrated proficiency and knowledge of painting techniques.
- Prior work with pneumatic spray gun, Hudson spray, airbrush a plus but not required.
- Strong Communication.
- Ability to be self-sufficient and self-motivated.
- Ability to prioritize and have good time management.
- Show an ability to learn and grow within the working environment, all while maintaining a healthy positive attitude.
